

NOTICE UNDER THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT – ADA

In accordance with the requirements of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 ("ADA"), the City of Grass Valley will not discriminate against qualified individuals with disabilities on the basis of disability in its services, programs, or activities.

The City of Grass Valley will seek to provide, upon request, appropriate aids and services leading to effective communication for qualified persons with disabilities so they can participate equally in the City of Grass Valley programs, services, and activities.

The City of Grass Valley will make reasonable modifications to policies and programs to ensure that people with disabilities have an equal opportunity to enjoy its programs, services, and activities.

Anyone who requires an auxiliary aid or service for effective communication, or a modification of policies or procedures to participate in a program, service, or activity of the City of Grass Valley, should contact Tim Kiser, ADA Coordinator, as soon as possible but no later than 48 hours before the scheduled event.

Complaints that a program, service, or activity of the City of Grass Valley is not accessible to persons with disabilities should be directed to Tim Kiser, ADA Coordinator.

ADA COORDINATOR

The ADA Coordinator is responsible for coordinating the efforts of the City of Grass Valley to comply with Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and investigating any concerns or complaints regarding access to City programs, services or activities. Tim Kiser, Public Works Director and City Engineer, has been designated as the ADA Coordinator.
